

## Visiting Artist Application Form

Leicester Print Workshop is a registered charity and a company limited by guarantee. We are also a printmaking community. All our members work together to ensure the workshop is a constructive, friendly, safe and clean place to practise. Visiting Artists will benefit from:

- Access to the workshop equipment and facilities during open hours
- Technicians available during open hours
- Opportunity to meet and work alongside other practicing artists
- Regular Enewsletter 'The Scoop'

Our Studio is open to printmakers who are confident and competent in their practice. To apply first fill out and submit this form, upon receipt one of our Studio Team will call to discuss your application and to arrange an induction. The induction gives us the opportunity to introduce the studio, how it works for your chosen technique and our health and safety procedures; it also presents you with the opportunity to demonstrate your competence. When your induction is scheduled we will talk with you about what you need to bring on the day. If at any stage in the process the LPW team feel you would benefit from additional teaching prior to using the Studio independently, they will discuss this with you.

Cost: £20 Induction, which is half a day (plus materials)  
£20 Half Day Studio Use or £40 Full Day Studio Use (plus materials)

Visiting Artists are required to have their own public liability insurance. We advise that Visiting Artists have their Induction in the morning and then use the Studio in the afternoon to become familiar with the equipment and layout.
